Parental Involvement

In order to assure collaborative relationships between ~~students'~~students' families and the District, and to enable ~~parent(s)/guardian(s)~~parents/guardians to become active partners in their children's education, the Superintendent shall:

1. Keep ~~parent(s)/guardian(s)~~parents/guardians thoroughly informed about their ~~child's~~child's school and education.
2. Encourage ~~parent(s)/guardian(s)~~parents/guardians to be involved in their ~~child's~~child's school and education.
3. Establish effective two-way communication between ~~parent(s)/guardian(s)~~parents/guardians and the District.
4. Seek input from ~~parent(s)/guardian(s)~~parents/guardians on significant school-related issues.
5. Inform parents/guardians on how they can assist their ~~children's~~children's learning.

The Superintendent shall periodically report to the School Board on the implementation of this policy.
