Middle School Summer School 2022

1. Qualifiers
  - a. Use [district policy](#) regarding failures to assign students
  - b. Core 5 subjects (excludes PE and Exploratories)
2. Funding
  - a. ESSER for learning loss used for funding
  - b. Staff paid according to Basic Agreement
3. Staffing
  - a. Potentially 5-6 Staff members for instruction
    - i. 3 - direct instruction for ELA and Math
    - ii. 1 - Special Education for Co-Taught classes
    - iii. 1 or 2 Staff (can be non-certified) - monitoring computer program for Science and Social Studies
  - b. One Principal and one secretary located in the building
  - c. Nurse to be shared by Central Campus
4. Structure
  - a. Hybrid of Teacher and Online
    - i. Teacher for English, Reading, and Math
      1. Combined Classes:  $\frac{7}{8}$  English,  $\frac{7}{8}$  Reading,  $\frac{7}{8}$  Math
      2. Cap at 20 kids per class, ideally 15
      3. Special Education students in Co-Taught classes
    - ii. Utilize IXL for Science and SS
      1. Can assign skills based on units students failed, if they didn't fail every unit
  - b. 3 class periods for AM summer school
    - i. Prioritize teacher-led instruction
      1. English, Reading, and Math
    - ii. The student's schedule will depend on the courses that they fail
    - iii. Class periods would be 55 minutes
  - c. Transportation provided by district
