Grades Pre-K - 4th

Options for 2020-2021 School year

In Person Learning:

Students will have in-person learning every day of the week.

or

Remote Learning

Students will be assigned to a Remote Learning Teacher. The student will utilize content through online platforms such as Google Meet. This learning will be synchronous.

Families will opt in to Remote Learning for an entire marking period. Grades

K-4: Trimester

Trimester One: September 8th - December 4th

Grades PreK-4

In person

- K-4: Capron Elementary, Manchester Elementary, Poplar Grove Elementary
 - Students will have in-person learning every day of the week.
 - Student dismissal will be 2:10 pm to allow for planning time for teachers and extra cleaning time for custodians.

Remote

- Designate 1 teacher at each grade level to be a Remote Learning teacher.
 - This teacher does not teach students in person; the teacher uses Google Meet to instruct students.
 - Students are rostered into this class if they select Remote Learning.
 - Students are required to continue Remote Learning for an entire grading period (trimester).
 - A student's Remote Learning teacher may not be from his/her home school.
- The Remote Learning teacher will report to a designated building and area where they will teach remotely.

- 2.5 hours of learning will be synchronous through Google Meet, as recommended by ISBE

In Person Learning:

Student will have in-person learning every day of the week.

or

Remote Learning:

Students will be rostered into a Remote Learning Class. This class period will be taught by a 5th-8th grade teacher. This will be synchronous learning through Google Meet

Families will opt in to Remote Learning for an entire marking period. Grades 5-8 Quarter

Quarter One: September 8th - November 6th

Grades 5-8

In person

- Students will have in-person learning every day of the week. Students will attend all classes each day.
- Student dismissal will be 1:55 pm to allow for planning time for teachers and extra cleaning time for custodians

Remote

- Our 5th-8th grade teachers teach 5-6 periods a day. One of their periods is designated a Remote Learning period.
 - During this Remote Learning period, the teacher teaches to students through Google Meet. The teacher does not have students in the classroom during this period.
 - Students are rostered into this class if they select Remote Learning.
 - Students are required to continue Remote Learning for an entire grading period (quarter).
- The Upper Elementary and Middle School will dismiss at 1:55 for in-person learning.

In Person Learning:

A Day: Students with last name A-L are in person and all other students are remote

B Day: Students with last name M-Z are in person and all other students are remote

C Day: all students remote

Remote Learning:

Students will access all content from Google Meet at home. This is synchronous learning Monday-Friday

Families will opt in to Remote Learning for an entire marking period.

Grades 9-12

Quarter One: September 8th - November 6th

Grades 9-12

In person

- NBHS will use a blended schedule for in-person instruction. Students will have in-person learning two (2) days a week and remote learning three (3) days a week. Students will attend all classes each day.
 - A Days (Monday and Tuesday) = Students with the last names A-L will attend school and participate remotely on B Days.
 - B Days (Thursday and Friday) = Students with the last names M-Z will attend school and participate remotely on A Days.
 - C Days - Every Wednesday, all students will engage in remote learning.
 - Teachers will stream their lessons for students who are home Remote Learning.

Remote

Full Remote Learning Students

- Teachers will use present mode in Google Meet to stream their lessons to students at home.
 - Teachers share the screen with students at home; sharing their screen will share their SmartBoard.
 - Other students in the class are not on video.
 - Teachers wear wireless headset to speak to and hear students at home.


