

Lessons Learned from Remote Learning: Survey Questions

Goal: To collaborate to create questions to survey stakeholders as part of a continuous improvement cycle related to distance learning.

Our stakeholder groups we would like to survey are teachers, families, and students. We would like to ask questions for the following categories: curriculum, social emotional, technology, and communication. We are also including an “other” category for you to share possible questions that may not fit into one of the above categories.

Here is one sample question from an outside survey:

Sample Curriculum Question for Families:

How many hours of the day is your student engaged in remote learning/e-learning for all classes? *

Less than 1 hour

1-3 hours each day

2-4 hours each day

More than 5 hours each day
