Changes:

- 43 kindergarten students will have a new teacher; 1 kindergarten teacher will have to move buildings and 2 kindergarten teachers will have a new assignment.
- 50 first grade students will have a new teacher; 3 first grade teachers will have a new assignment.
- 52 second grade students will have a new teacher; 3 second grade teachers will have a new assignment.
- 31 third grade students will have a new teacher; 2 third grade teachers will have a new assignment.
- 26 fourth grade students will have a new teacher; 1 fourth grade teacher will have a new assignment.
- The total adjustments result in 202 students of 507 (40%) at K-4 being assigned a new teacher, 1 teacher moving buildings, and 11 teachers in a new assignment.

Daily Structure:

- Students will attend on an A/B day schedule with half of the students in-person each day.
- When students are not in-person, they will not receive direct instruction from their teachers. They may have independent activities to do at home.
- Students would have to eat lunch in their classrooms. Additional staff may be needed for lunch supervision.
- Health department guidelines regarding shared materials in the classroom and for PE, music, and art will be followed.
