- \*6 air brake buses

29 buses (19 in daily rotation)

4 vans, 1 Yukon, 2 trucks

1 white bus

# Long Range Plan



2018-2019: Purchase 10 buses per year for 3 years  
then move to a bus rotation of replacing 5 to 6 buses  
every year.

- \*Purchase 2 buses with undercarriage (77 passenger)
- \*Purchase 2 buses (77 passenger)
- \*Purchase 1 White Bus (in addition to the one we have)

# 2020-2021 Bus Purchases



- \*Trade in 6 buses
- \*Purchase 1 bus with undercarriage (77 passenger)
- \*Purchase 3 buses (77 passenger)
- \*Purchase Yukon and or District Van  
(Potential budget of \$375,000)

# 2021-2022 Bus Purchases



- \*Trade in 3 buses
- \*Purchase 3 buses
- \*Possible Van replacement
- \*Potential budget \$300,000

# 2022-2023 & Beyond



Trade in 5 or 6 buses and replace 5 or 6 buses on 5  
year rotation  
(Potential budget \$400,000)
