## **High School Course Equivalency Summary**

In May, Jake Hubert sent out a survey to the high school staff seeking their input on graduation, GPA, Val/Sal, and outside credits. From that data, a group of four teachers, a counselor, a secretary, and Jake coordinated to meet to discuss the survey results and make recommendations to board. The final discussion was attended by Kendra Stachowiak, Nick Augustine, Amy Velez, Kristi Garman, and Jake Hubert. Recommendations are as follows:

- 1. Keep senior's last day around the same time, but move graduation back one week. This will allow more time for the counseling office to perform credit checks from schools students earn credit outside the school, allow time for GPA to be calculated, and allow to use 8th semester GPA to be used to determine Val/Sal. The one drawback is that the WREX top of the class needed by the beginning of May.
- 2. Allow students who take a class off campus, to earn weighted credit if they can take an exam for college credit that is tied to the class. The student does not actually have to take the exam.
- 3. Allow students to retake a core curriculum class they failed once.
