We are pleased to inform you that the Capital Development Board (CDB) has awarded a school construction grant to your district in the amount of \$13,545,489.00 for the construction of the two-story, 27-classroom North Boone High School for 615 students in 9th-12th grades; a later phase provided for the construction of a two-story, 8-classroom addition to the North Boone High School for 200 students in 9th-12th grades; construction of a one-story, 6-classroom addition to the North Boone Upper Elementary School for 150 students in 5th-6th grades; construction of a two-story, 13-classroom addition to the Poplar Grove Elementary School for 325 students in K-4th grades; and, renovation of the existing cafeteria space at the Manchester Elementary School to create an additional classroom for 25 students in K-4th grades.
