- Based on 2nd semester failures.
- Will use Board Policy 6:280 to identify students
 - Student fails 1-3 classes, attends summer school
 - Student fails 3+ classes, attends summer school and may be considered for retention

Will use current online resources to provide skill recovery.



Grades 7-8 Instructional Program

Skill recovery for ELA, Reading, and Math.

- Based on 2nd semester failures.
- Will use Board Policy 6:280 to identify students
 - Student fails 1-3 classes, attends summer school
 - Student fails 3+ classes, attends summer school and may be considered for retention

Will use Edgenuity MyPath (already purchased) for skill recovery.



Grades 9-12 Instructional Program

Credit Recovery offered by North Boone Teachers: Semester 1 Courses

- Geometry
- World Cultures
- Physical Science
- General Chemistry

Minimum Class Size = 5 students
for these four courses.

Other courses offered through Educere online program.

- Students pay \$100 per course that is refunded once the student earns a passing grade.
