The Committee discussed allowing farmland owners (that do not reside in our District) to send their students to North Boone Schools. The school taxes paid would be considered toward the state set cost of tuition. The Committee was not opposed to the

change in policy, but wished to address the topics of LLC's and trusts with legal counsel.

6.300..... Graduation Requirements

Mr. Hubert noted the community service requirement for graduation was above and beyond the state requirement. We currently hold high school diplomas until community service is completed. The original purpose was to provide for an opportunity of civic engagement, however, in some cases this requirement can become punitive if the student cannot complete the requirement due to other obligations or conflicts. There was discussion to possibly add this as a credit or include on a transcript. The Committee felt additional options should be discussed by the high school staff to determine the future of this graduation requirement.
