Student Assignment and Intra-District Transfer

Attendance Areas

The School District is divided into school ~~boundary~~attendance areas.- The Superintendent will review the boundary lines annually and recommend any changes to the School Board of Education. The Superintendent or designee shall maintain a map of the District showing current school attendance areas. Students living in a given school attendance area will be assigned to that school. Homeless children shall be assigned according to Board policy 6:140, *Education of Homeless Children*.

Transfers ~~within~~Within the District

The Board of Education allows several options for students to attend various schools within the district. It is a goal of the District to maintain class size limits within the various grade levels of the various attendance centers.

- Students shall attend their local school as defined by the map mentioned above.
- Students will be required to attend another school in the North Boone School District in order to maintain class size limits within the grade level.
- Students may participate in the Voluntary Transfer Program and attend any school in the district, in accordance with the procedures listed in Administrative Procedure 7:30.2.

The Board may grant an exception when the parent(s)/guardian(s) demonstrate that the student could be better accommodated by the education program at another school, provided space is available. Students who are granted a transfer within the District shall be responsible for their own transportation. The provisions in this section have no applicability to transfers pursuant to: ~~(1) Title I and covered in Board policy 6:15, School Accountability, or (2) the Unsafe School Choice Option covered in Board policy 4:170, safety~~Safety.

Class ~~Assignment~~Assignments

The Superintendent or designee shall assign students to classes.
