Progress - Middle School Curriculum

Accomplishment 1

 Teachers are currently implementing new resources in Reading/ELA and Social Studies.

Accomplishment 2

 We are having curriculum meetings each quarter to check-in on implementation and pacing during the first year.



Accomplishment 1

 Middle School students have completed the SEL Screener (SDQ) and the data has been disaggregated to show individual needs and building trends.

Accomplishment 2

 Mindfulness/Yoga - All students learned how mindfulness and yoga can be used to regulate their emotions and as a new coping skill with difficult situations in and out of school (Tier 1). PE classes followed up with a day of yoga with a certified yoga instructor.



Accomplishment 3

 Positive Self-talk - 8th Grade students developed/increased their understanding of what it means to use positive self-talk as a means of taking responsibility for their actions, their coping, and themselves

Accomplishment 4

- Career Education All students
- 7th grade students learned about Xello, explored how their interests can turn into a career, and how to use career clusters.
- 8th grades students learned about life skills in the workplace as well as the various career pathways available to them.



Accomplishment 5

 Leadership- All middle school students participated in discussions to identify the qualities they looked for in a leader and helped develop a definition for what it means to be a leader at their grade level.

Accomplishment 6

 Organization - 7th grade students learned basic function of Google Drive, gMail, and how to keep both organized throughout the school year.

 Digital Citizenship- 7th & 8th grade students participated in discussion & activities to learn about their digital habits and the impact these habits have on their lives.

 Standards Alignment & Data -Tier 1 classroom interventions are being aligned to the Mindsets & Behaviors identified by the American School Counseling Association. Data is used to identify Tier 1 and Tier 2 interventions.

Progress - Middle School Learning Loss

Accomplishment 1

Math Intervention: Students meeting the criteria for intervention completed work in Edgenuity and received support from staff to improve Math skills. Of the enrolled students, over 50% saw growth on their MAPs Assessment and/or improved their math grades to passing.

Accomplishment 2

• For 4th quarter, students failing 2 or more courses for the year have been enrolled in an Intervention Study Hall in lieu of an Exploratory class.

Accomplishment 3

• During Study Hall, students who are struggling will be assigned either peer or staff tutors.

• ELA / Reading teachers are meeting to analyze IAR Evidence Statement reports in order to prepare for the upcoming IAR.

School Counselor will continue with classroom lessons. Small group and individual Social Work and Counseling sessions will continue as needed.
