- 2. Girls will read on Tuesday afternoons, and boys will read on Thursdays. I will guide the reading of a chapter book. The reading process will involve silent reading, partner reading, round robin reading, choral reading, and modeled teacher reading. Each afternoon will begin with a fluency warm-up. Strategy practice for comprehension will focus on a specific strategy for the day while using the reciprocal teaching square: prediction, clarification, questioning, and summarization. Common core standards with an emphasis on text-dependent questions will also be reinforced during our reading sessions.
- 3. The reading groups will meet in my room on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:50-3:30 p.m. October 17th to December 12th (14 sessions in total). I will write a review of our reading experience and collect and analyze student and parent surveys.
- 4. The total hours of this project are 9.3 hours of student direction and 2 hours of planning/ preparation from October to December for a total of 11.3 hours. I will provide the books.
