Athletic Milestone Advertising Program

The following advertising program is based on the advertiser being mentioned in each home game when the following athletic milestones are reached by the North Boone varsity team. At the end of each season, the District will invoice Poplar Grove Bank based upon the following criteria:

Fall Season

- \$25- For every home touchdown scored
- \$25- For every home service ace scored in volleyball
- \$25- For every CC team or individual win
- \$25- For every home soccer goal
- \$25- For every home golf birdie or hole in one

Winter Season

- \$25- For every 3-point basket scored at home
- \$25- For every home wrestling pin

Spring Season

- \$25- For breaking school records in Track and Field
- \$25- For each home run in softball and baseball
- \$25- For every home soccer goal

Each season's invoice will be capped at \$1,000.00.

In exchange, the District will display appropriate signage where the contests are being played with program details and advertising Poplar Grove State Bank as the sole sponsor of the program. The cost of the signage to be borne 50% / 50% by both parties.

This agreement will extend through the Fall 2017 to the Spring 2018 season. The program will abide by all IHSA rules and regulations.
