This Behavioral Consulting Service Agreement ("Agreement") between Behavioral Perspective, Inc., an Illinois corporation, ("Consultant") and North Boone School District ("Client") is hereby entered into and made effective August 27, 2018. Consultant and Client hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth below.

#### SECTION 1. Services to be Provided

- A. Consultant shall provide to Client the described services ("Services") authorized in the Service Request Authorization Form (page 4) with regard to Students or Staff referred to BPI from North Boone School District, as identified by administrators. Client hereby consents to and confirms that Consultant's employees have Client's express written permission to utilize the program known as Quality Behavioral Solutions as developed and promulgated by QBS, Inc. Any use of QBS will conform to the standards as set forth by QBS, Inc. and further shall confirm to the policies and procedures of Client to the extent that Client has made Consultant and its employees aware. Consultant's employees will use QBS only when warranted to ensure the nonviolent resolution to any student's aggressive, self-injurious and/or maladaptive behavior in order to protect Student, other students and Client's staff.
- C. Pursuant to relevant state and Federal laws, Consultant and its employees acknowledges and confirms its obligation to keep confidential any and all student's academic and health information that it may learn of or become privy to in the performs of the Services.

#### Section 3. Contract Period

- A. The Term of this Agreement shall commence on August 27, 2018, and shall continue through and including June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Thereafter, it shall continue in full force and effect from <u>year</u> to <u>year</u> unless either party hereto shall serve written notice of cancellation.
- B. This Agreement may be terminated by either party by providing seven (7) days written notice to the other party. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Agreement may be immediately terminated by either party without prior written notice to the other party for any action or inaction by the non-terminating party based on the safety and well-being of Consultant's employees and/or Student as defined above.

#### Section 4. Indemnification

A. Consultant and Client shall each indemnify and hold the other harmless (except to the extent the indemnified party is compensated by insurance) against all losses, claims, damages or liabilities arising out of or based upon damage to property of the indemnified party or bodily injury or death of any employee of the indemnified party, caused by or related to the performance of work under or pursuant to this Agreement, provided that the property damage, personal injury or death does not result from the sole negligence of the indemnified party.

## Section 5. Non-solicitation

A. Client shall not employ or independently contract with, in any capacity whatsoever, any employee, agent or consultant of Consultant whom performed Services pursuant to this Agreement for a period of one year from the termination of this Agreement without the prior written consent of Consultant.
