## <u>Students</u>

## Student Fund-RaisingFundraising Activities

Only the following organizations may solicit<u>No individual or organization is allowed to ask</u> students to participate in fundraising activities while the students are on school grounds during school hours or during any school activity to engage in fund raising activities. Exceptions are:

- <u>1.</u> <u>1.</u> School-sponsored student organizations; and
- 2. 2. Parent organizations and booster clubs that are recognized pursuant to policy 8:90, *Parent Organizations and Booster Clubs*<sub>7.</sub>
  - 3. Or as designated by the <u>The</u> Superintendent

The Superintendent's implementing procedures or designee shall provide that: manage student fundraising activities in alignment with the following directives:

- <u>1.</u> <u>Fund-raisingFundraising</u> efforts shall not conflict with instructional activities or programs.
- 2. <u>Fund raisingFor any school that participates in the School Breakfast Program or the National School Lunch Program, fundraising activities involving the sale of food and beverage items to students during the school day while on the school campus must comply with the Ill. State Board of Education rules concerning the sale of competitive food and beverage items.</u>
- 3. Participation in fundraising efforts must be voluntary.
- <u>4.</u><u>3.</u>Student safety ismust be paramount and door to door solicitations are prohibited.
- 5. 4. For <u>Schoolschool</u>-sponsored student organizations, a school staff member must supervise the <u>fund-raisingfundraising</u> activities and the student activity funds treasurer must safeguard the financial accounts.
- <u>6.</u> <u>5.</u> The <u>fund-raisingfundraising</u> efforts must be to support the organization's purposes and/or activities, the general welfare, a charitable cause, or the educational experiences of students generally.
- <u>7.</u> <u>6.</u> The funds shall be used to the maximum extent possible for the designated purpose.
- 8. 7. Any fund-raisingfundraising efforts that solicit donor messages for incorporation into school property-(, e.g., tiles or bricks), or placement upon school property-(, e.g., posters or placards), must:

  - <u>b.</u> Inform potential donors that all messages are subject to review and approval, and —that messages that do not meet the established guidelines must be resubmitted or the ——donation will be returned; and
  - c. \_\_\_\_\_Place a disclaimer on all fundraising information and near the completed donor \_\_\_\_\_\_messages that all messages are "solely the expression of the individual donors and \_\_\_\_\_not an endorsement <u>by the District</u> of any message's content <u>by the District</u>."
