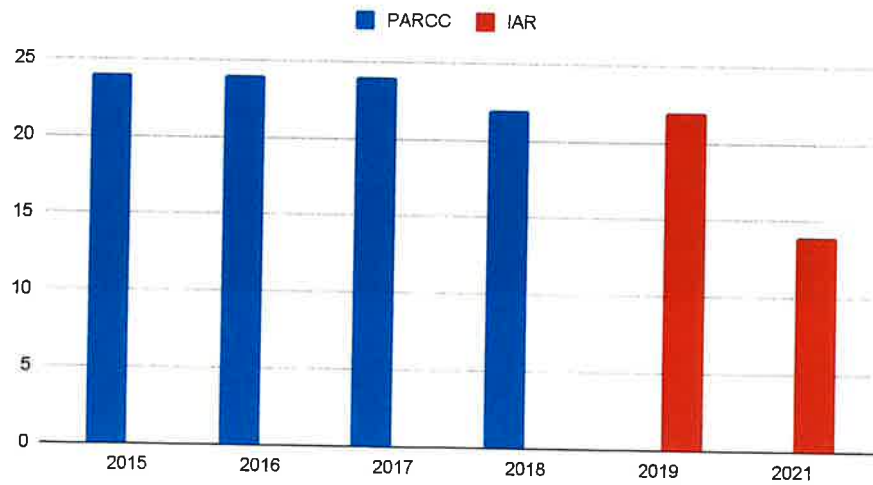

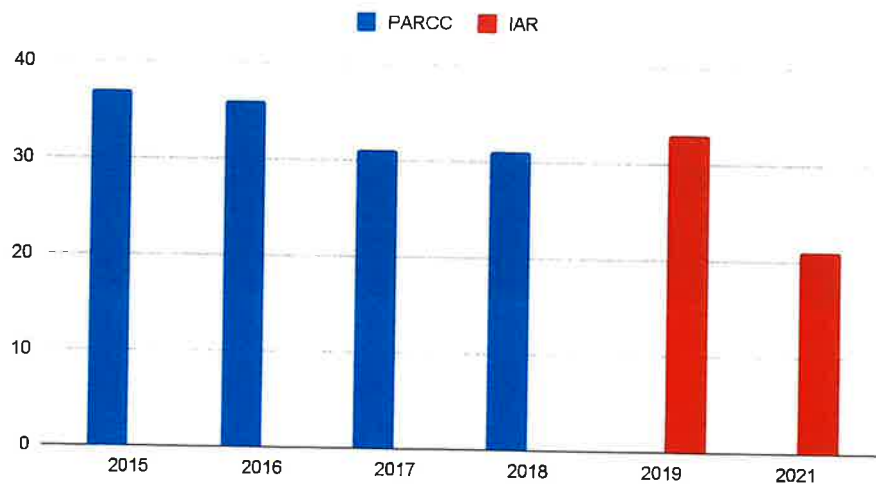

Math Percent Meeting / Exceeding



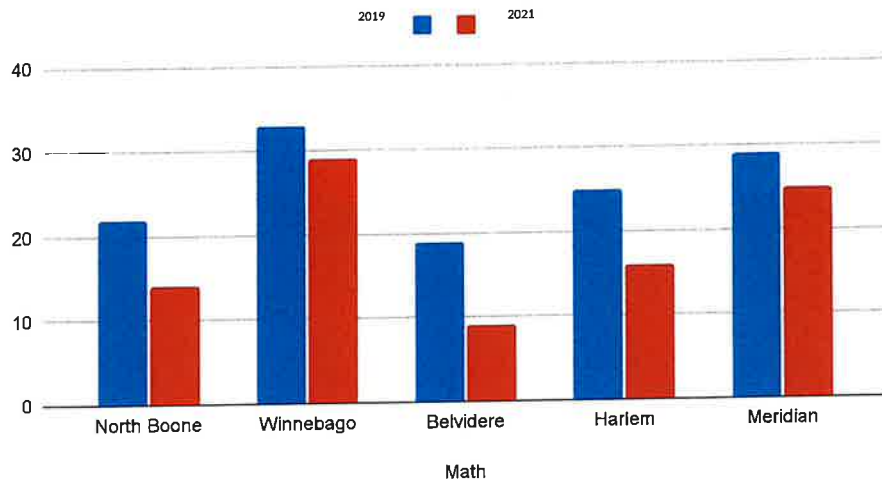

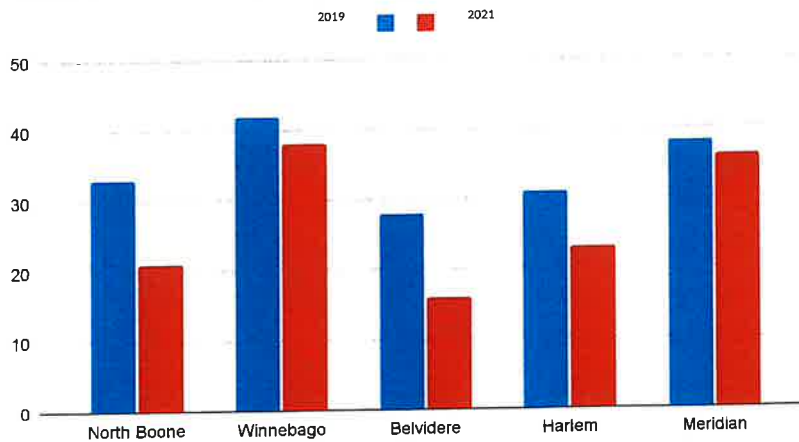

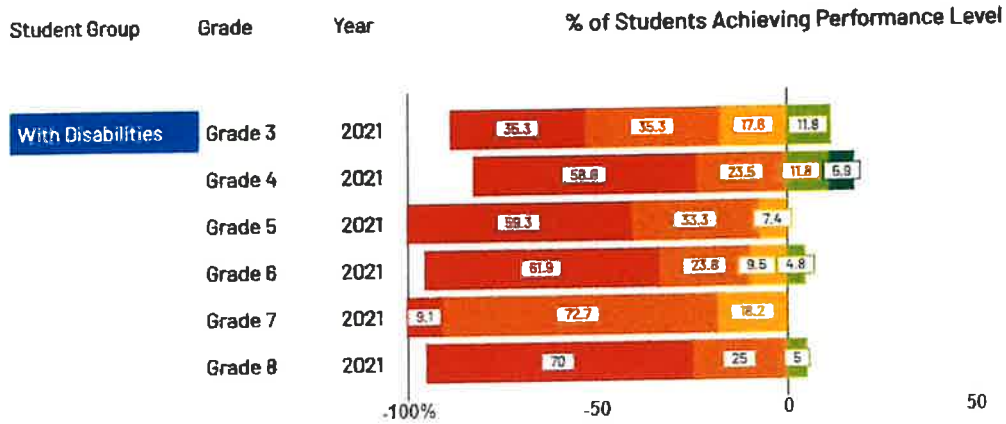


## Grade Level Data by Subgroup



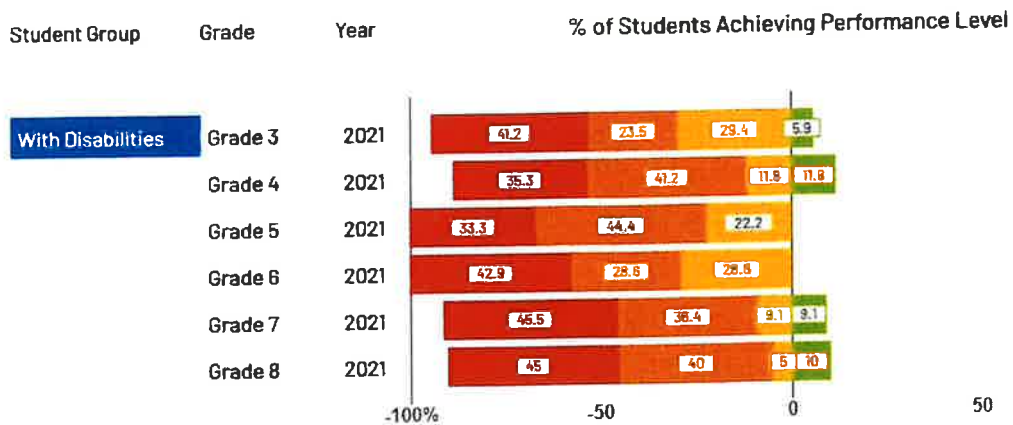

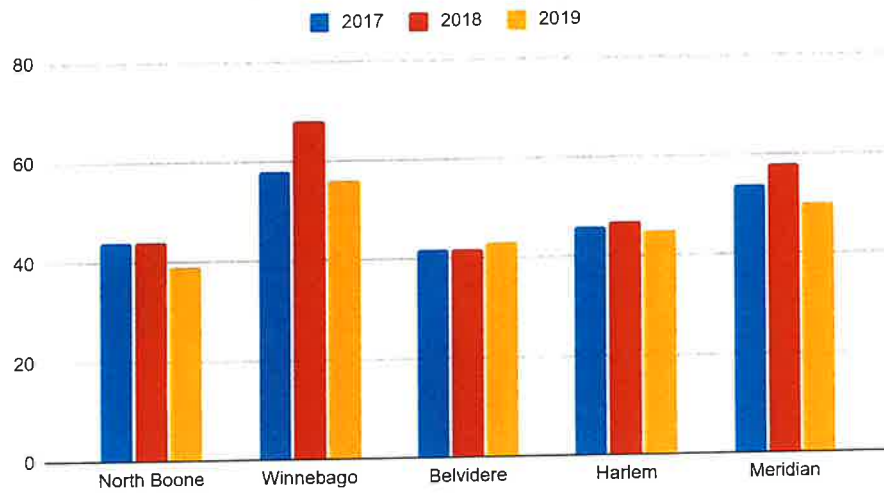


# ISA: Trend Data by Year

Percent Proficient: Comparative Data



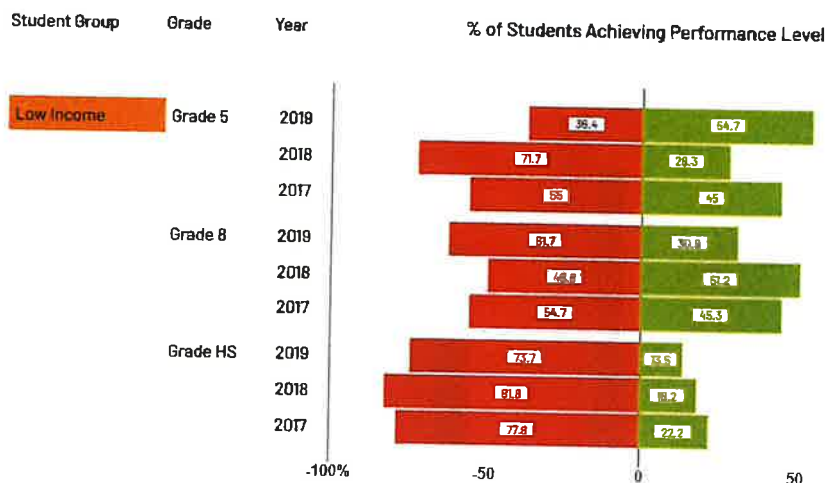

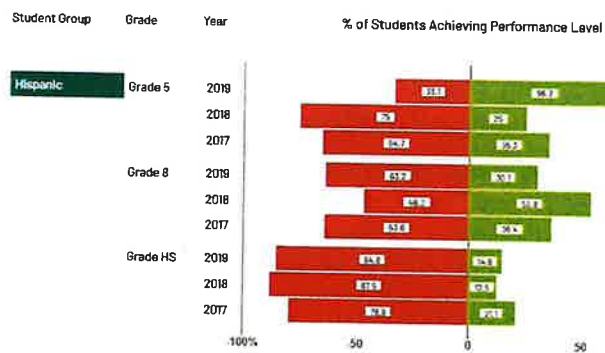

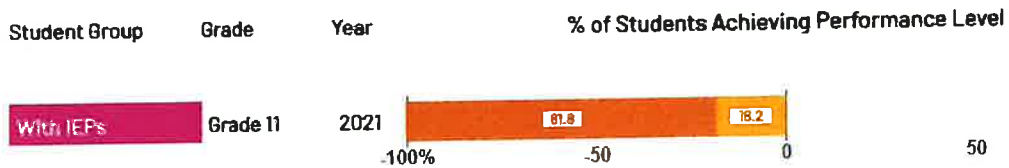

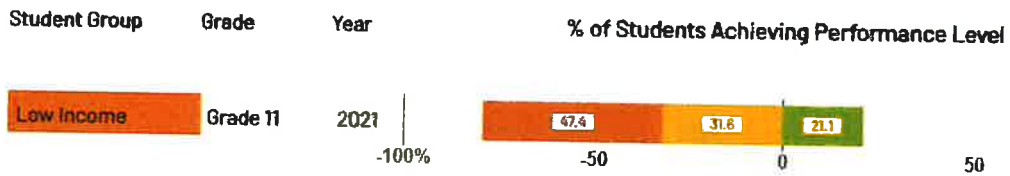

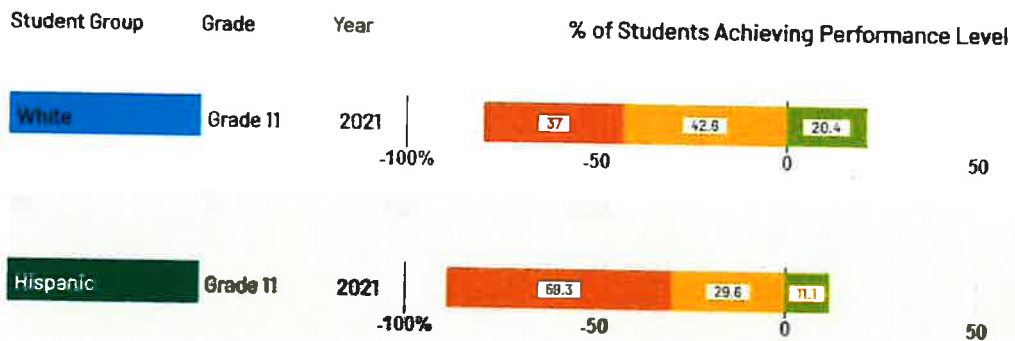

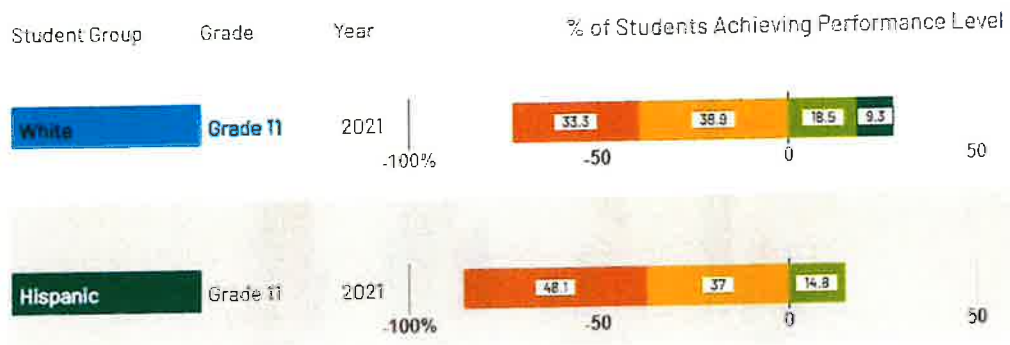

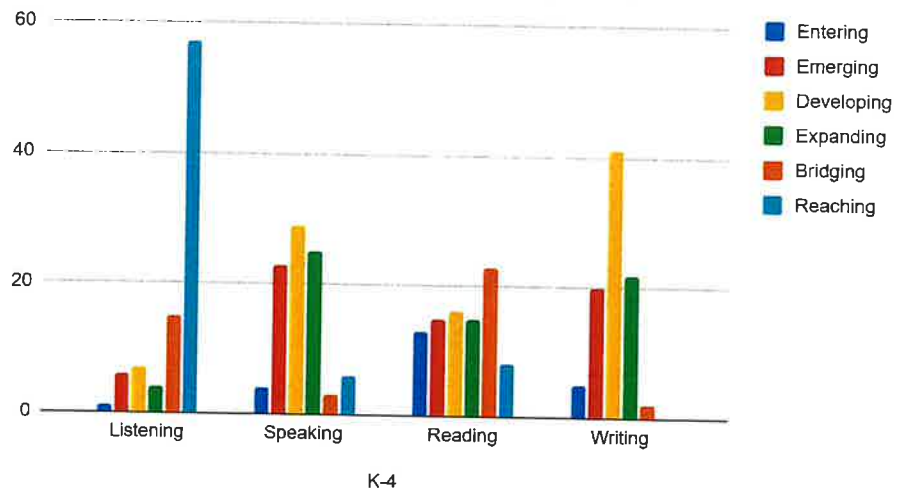
# ACCESS: 2019 K-4 Data

Number of Students at Each Proficiency Level



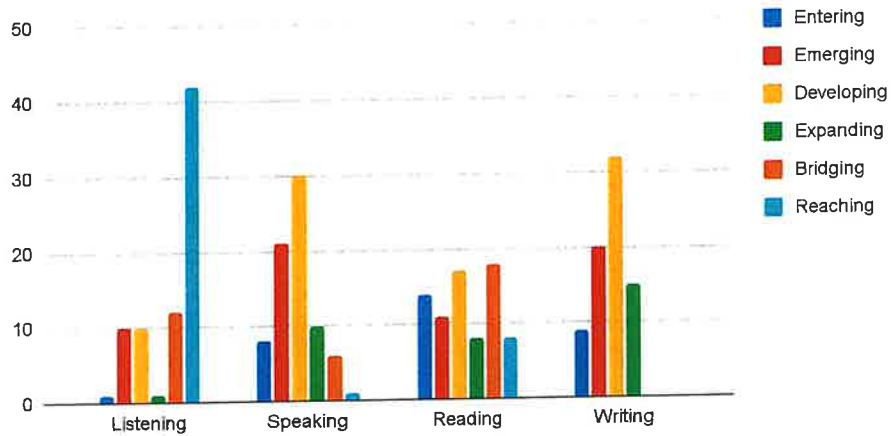

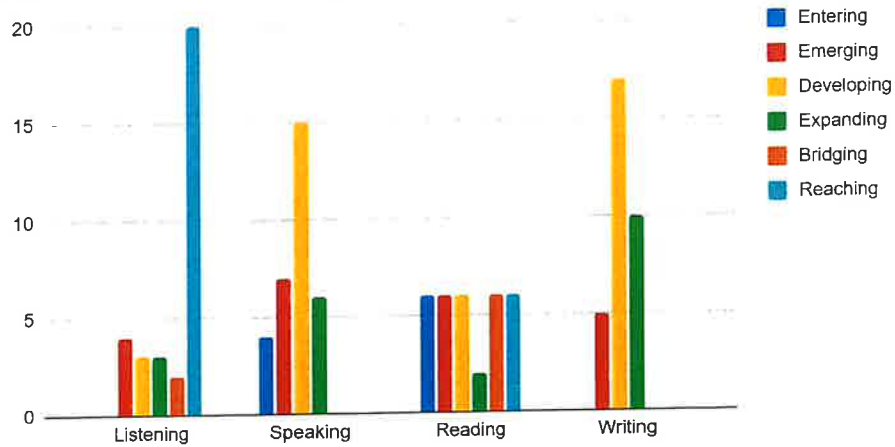

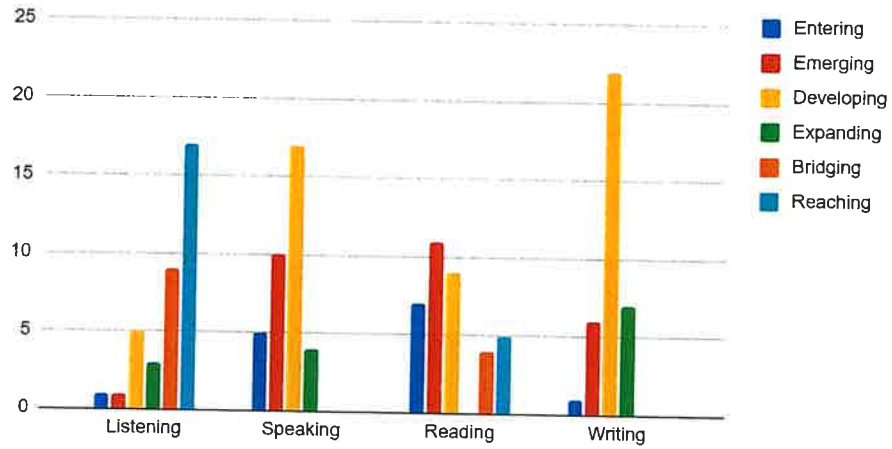

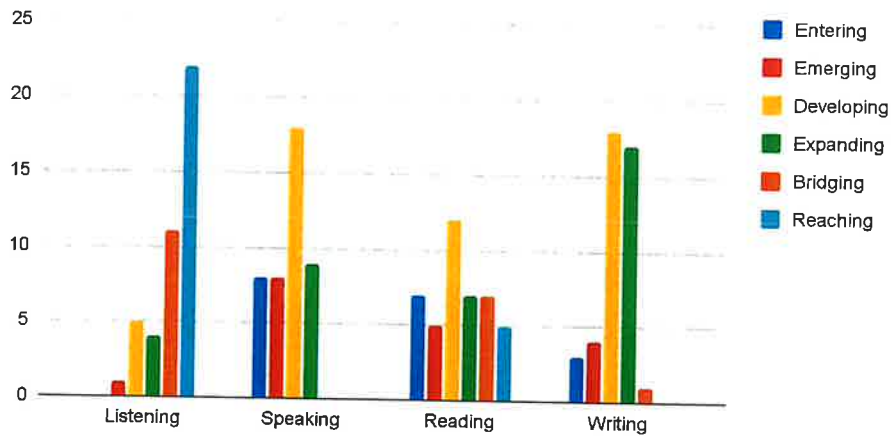
Number of Students at Each Proficiency Level

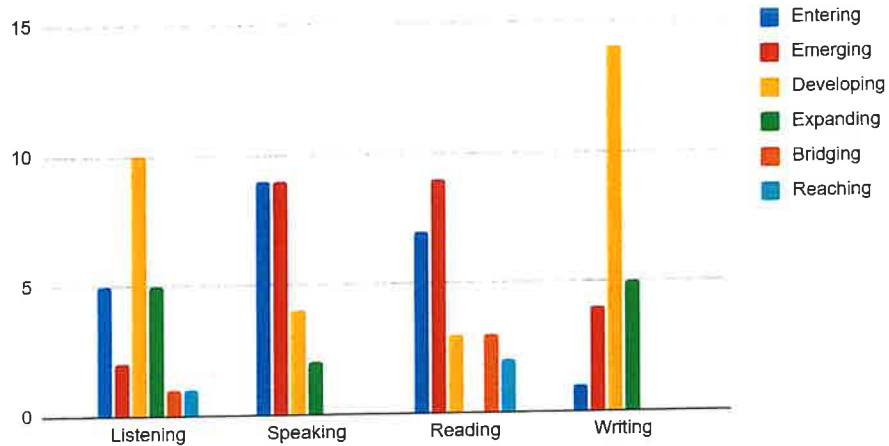
Number of Students at Each Proficiency Level

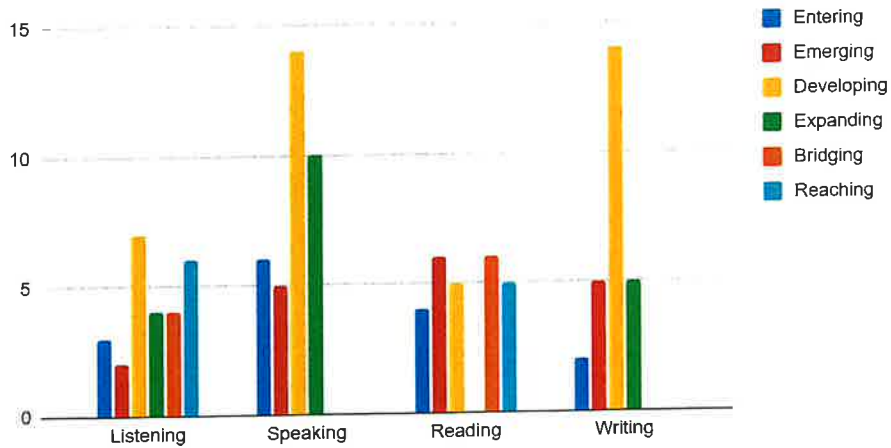
Number of Students at Each Proficiency Level

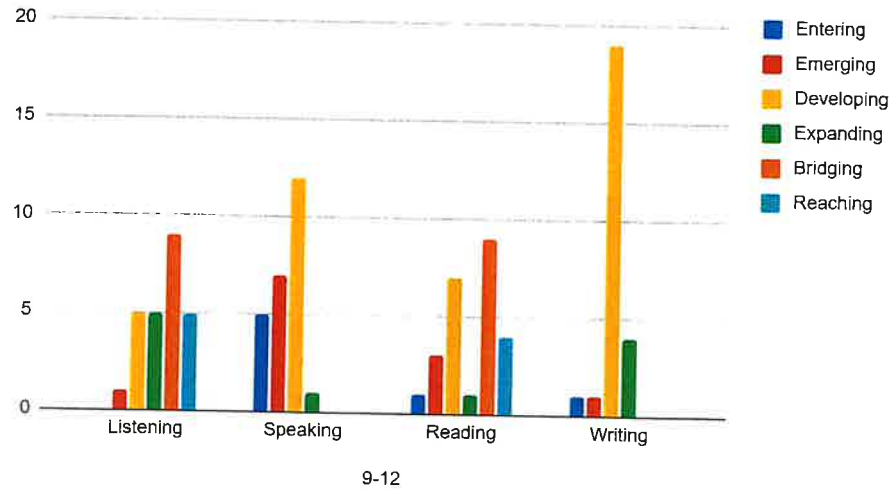

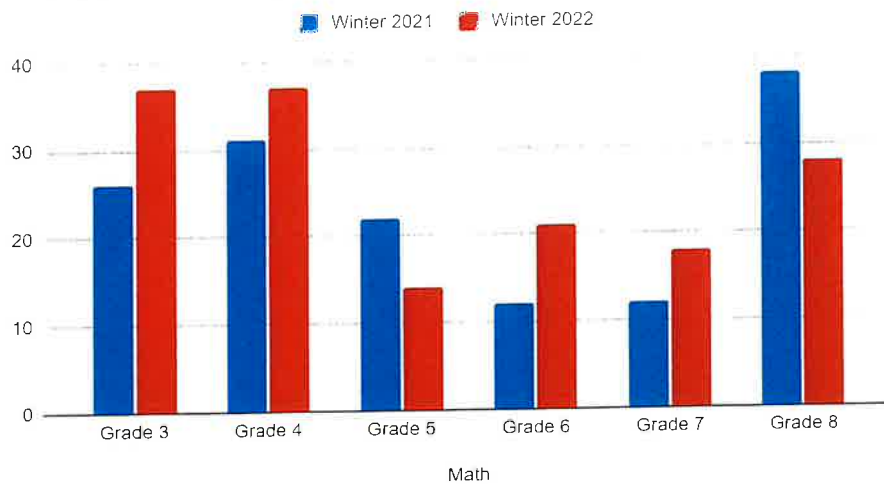

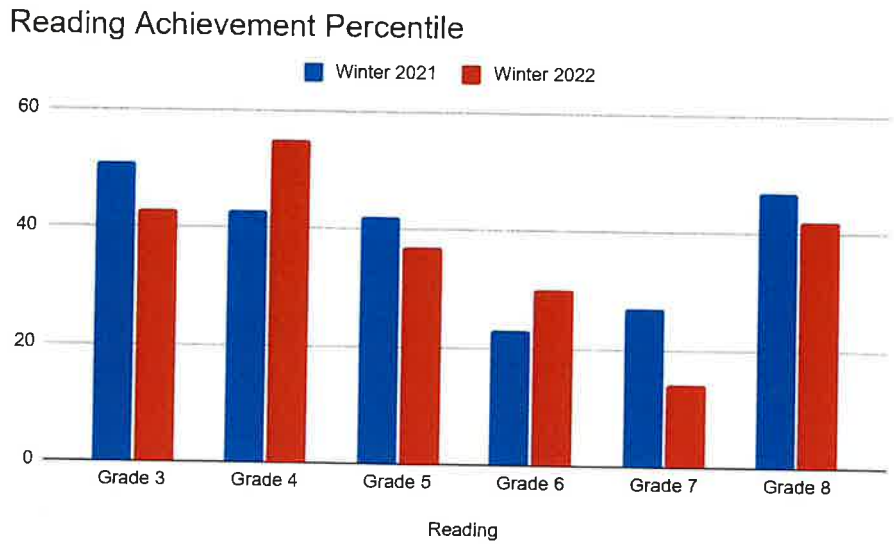

## MAPs: Math Winter 2021-Winter 2022 Achievement Percentile

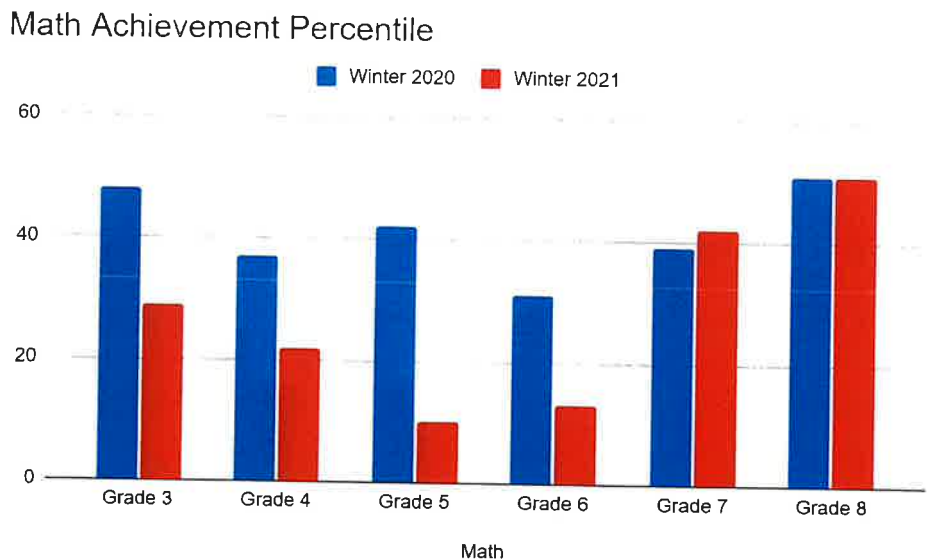
Math Achievement Percentile



# MAPs: Reading Winter 2021-Winter 2022 Achievement Percentile



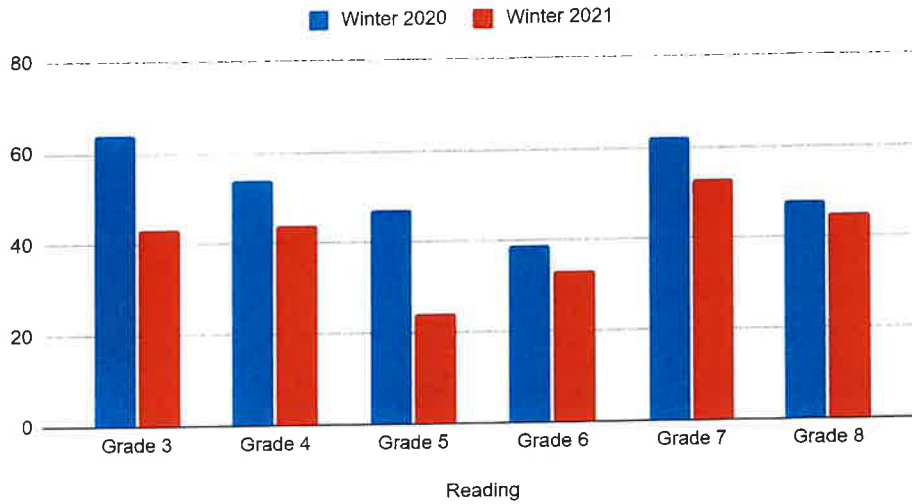
# MAPs: Math Winter 2020-Winter 2021 Achievement Percentile

Reading Achievement Percentile

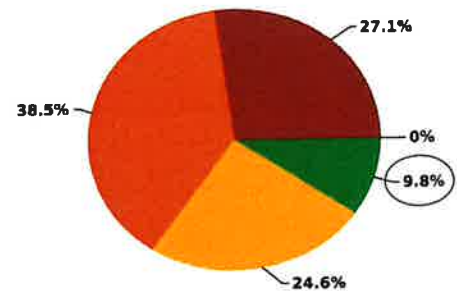
