- Add one SPED Teacher (\$55,000)
- Bring lunches back to the UE to fit scheduling

# **High School**

- Pilot SAT Prep with 1 teacher in English and 1 Teacher in Math
- Add Mastery Manager to support SAT Test Prep (Costs would be swapped from MAP Testing to PSAT and MM)
- Continue to make a long term plan for vocational and elective courses for the high school.

# **Technology**

- 165 Chromebooks for Grades K-6
  - UE = 60 devices

- Poplar Grove = 30 Devices
- O Capron = 30 Devices
- Manchester = 30 Devices
- O Tech Extra = 15 Devices
- High School Smart Board (\$2000)
