- Two day Professional Development with Andrew Sharos.

- Pop quizzes on reading.

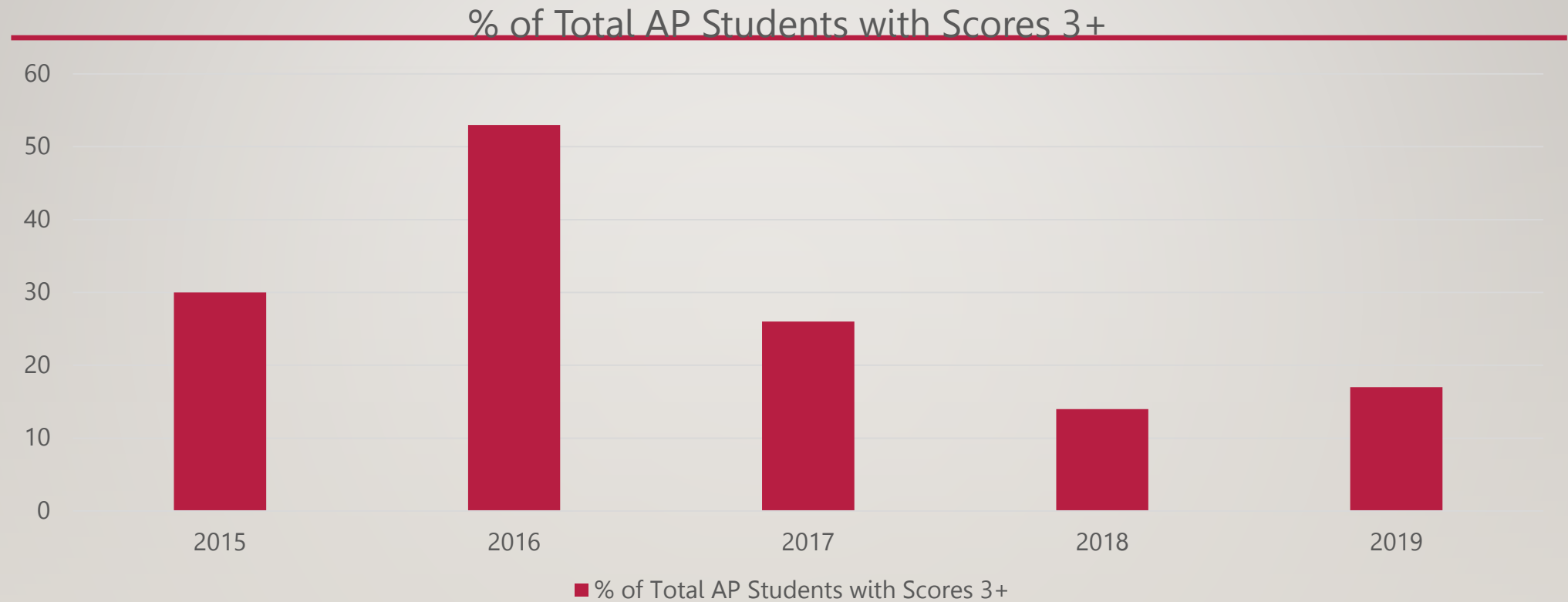

- Fewer students taking AP class during the 2019-2020 school year, which led to fewer courses being offered.
- First year with highest percentage of students not being in the 1's.
- Student survey shows 25% of students keep up with the reading.
