



# GENERAL INFORMATION

- Located at the UE and the MS
- June 1st June 26th, Monday through Friday
- Staff hours will be 8:15 to 3:15.
- These times include 30 minutes of planning for teachers and 30 minutes for TAs to transition students on and off buses before and after school. Time also includes a 30 minute lunch.
- Student hours will be 8:30 11:30 for Session 1 and 12:00 3:00 for Session 2
- There will be a 30 minute lunch break from 11:30-12:00 for students staying for both sessions.



### CREDIT RECOVERY STRUCTURE

- Credit recovery for English/Reading, Math,
  Science, and Social Studies
- If students failed 1 or 2 courses, they attend the morning session.
- If students failed 3 or 4 courses, they attend both the morning and afternoon sessions.



## MEETING SEL NEEDS

As part of the program, a certified School Counselor or School Social Worker will create and coordinate push-in and pull-out services to address the varying SEL needs of students attending Summer School. Services may include, but are not limited to individual, small group, and whole group instruction in study skills, goal setting, stress management, and planning for future success.



#### HIGH SCHOOL NEEDS

- ★ Due to extended school closures, students may need to take credit recovery over the summer
- **★** Offer these classes through an online platform
- ★ \$100.00 per class/per student
- **★** Unsure of the enrollment projections yet
- ★ Would require 1 teacher per 20 student enrolled in program
