Potential motion: Move to approve the purchase of Into Reading (grade 5) and Into Literature (grades 6-8) by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt (Comprehensive Package) for \$97,507.29.

Recommended action: Approve the motion

The Administration recommends that the Board approve the purchase of Into Reading / Into Literature by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt. This package will cost \$97,507.29 and will provide reading and English Language Arts resources to grades 5-8 for 6 years.

District has set aside \$75,000 for professional development at the District level. This funding comes from local funds as well as Title Grants.

Recommendation for Adoption

5th-8th Grade English Language Arts Curriculum Resources

Rationale:

A new ELA resource for grades 5-8 will provide the following advantages for teachers and students.

- Alignment with the rigor and focus of our identified priority Common Core State Standards in English Language Arts.
- Integration of reading, writing, speaking, and grammar skills to support our reading and English curricula with a common resource and to support the integration of skills as required by the Common Core State Standards.

Process:

In order to arrive at this recommendation, our 5th-8th grade ELA committee engaged in the following process.

- October 2019-February 2020
 - Common Core State Standards in ELA were reviewed to select Priority standards at each grade level. Priority standards are those which are to be mastered at grade level and for which local assessments should be developed in order to monitor progress and achievement and provide interventions as needed.
 - Priority standards were “unpacked” into learning targets and proficiency levels in order to create common understanding of their meaning.
 - Teachers serving on the committee attended vendor presentations for three curriculum series: *Into Reading / Into Literature* by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt, *My View / My Perspectives* by Savvas (formerly Pearson), and *Wonders / Study Sync* by McGraw Hill. The committee selected two resources to pilot.
 - Teachers selected specific units to pilot and mapped out their weeks of instruction.
 - Teachers reviewed evaluation rubrics to be used by the committee.
- February 2020-May 2020
 - Teachers piloted *Into Reading* (Gr. 5) / *Into Literature* (Gr.6-8) by HMH.
 - As grade level teams, teachers completed the Priority Standard Rubric and the Resource Component Rubric for HMH resource.
 - 7th grade completed pilot for *My Perspectives* by Savvas (formerly Pearson). Had to stop the pilot because of COVID school closures.
- September 2020 - October 2020
 - Teachers piloted *My View* (Gr. 5) / *My Perspectives* (Gr.6-8) by Savvas (formerly Pearson).
 - As grade level teams, teachers completed the Priority Standard Rubric and the Resource Component Rubric for Savvas resource.

Recommendation:

The *Into Reading / Into Literature* series published by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt is recommended for adoption as our 5th-8th grade ELA resource. The following features of the series stand out as key reasons for our recommendation.

- Requires students to engage with rigorous texts.

- Texts and materials reflect a diverse and inclusive perspective on the world, free of bias and prejudice.
- Provides a variety of differentiation opportunities and intervention supports for students who need additional learning support.
- Uses varied modes of curriculum-embedded assessments that may include pre-tests, formative and summative assessments, and self-evaluation measures.
- Assessments generate data that provides opportunities for analysis and reflection.
- Texts and materials align to our Priority Standards and provide multiple opportunities for skill development and practice.
