ATTACHMENT X-D: 2017 General Education Summer School Program

Suggested Motion: Move to approve the General Education Summer School Program

Recommended Action: Approve as presented.

It is recommended that we offer a General Education Summer School Program this summer for students currently enrolled in Kindergarten and 1st grades. The program will be four days per week for five weeks. Cost breakdown is attached along with additional program information.

Program Dates: May 30 – June 2, June 5-8, 12-15, 19-22, 26-29

Program Times: 8:30 – 11:30 am

In addition to the academic program, students attending will have the opportunity to attend After Care provided by the YMCA. Families will have to pay for this care according to the YMCA guidelines. Transportation will not be provided from the After Care program and will be the parents' responsibilities.

It is also recommended that a summer program for students that have failed classes in grades 5th – 8th attend a summer school class during the same dates to fulfill promotion requirements. Attendance would be for 20 days at 2.5 hours per day.

Transportation will be provided for Regular Education and ELL Summer School.

North Boone CUSD Summer School Proposal

General Education Summer School

1. Target Students: Current Kindergarten and 1st grade students from all elementary buildings that were identified as significantly below grade level expectations. Recommendations were determined by academic performance, not a ratio per building. There will be one Kindergarten class and one 1st Grade class, each enrolling a maximum of 15 students.
2. Staffing: Each class will be staffed by one certified teacher and one teacher assistant. A building administrator, school nurse, and secretary will be hired for this program as well as the EL and ESY Programs taking place concurrently.
3. Program Curriculum: Scholastic Lit Camp: A 5-week program that combines innovative, research-based curricula with an engaging and interactive summer camp structure geared to improve literacy skills, motivation, curiosity, and encourage students to become lifelong readers and learners.
4. Program Structure: The program will be five weeks in length with students attending Camp for three hours per day, four days per week. Teachers will have 30 minutes of planning and preparation each day.
5. It is also recommended that a class for students in grades 5th – 8th that have failed classes attend summer school during the same dates to fulfill promotion requirements. Attendance would be for 20 days at 2.5 hours per day.
6. Transportation will be provided for General Education, Bilingual, and Special Education Summer School Programs.
