<u>Administrative Procedure – <u>Academic</u> Eligibility for Participation in Extracurricular <u>Activities</u></u>

Actor	Action
Building Principal	Include the minimum academic and attendance criteria for participation in the Student-Parent Athletic Handbook.
Coach or Sponsor	Explain the minimum academic and attendance criteria for participation and Extracurricular Discipline Code to student participants.
Student	In order to be eligible to participate, <i>maintain an overall</i> grade point average must meet the academic and attendance eriteria as stated in the Student-Parent Athletic Handbook and not be in violation of the Extracurricular Discipline Code.
Coach or Sponsor	Before allowing a student to join an extracurricular activity, ensure that he or she <i>the student</i> meets the academic criteria and not be in violation of the Extracurricular Discipline Code.
Building Principal or designee	At the end of each grade reporting period, arrange for all coaches and sponsors to have access to their student-participants' grades and grade point averages week, mail a report to parent's of students who fail to meet academic criteria. Provide a copy of the report to coaches and sponsors.
Building Principal or designee	Notify the coach or sponsor if a student is ineligible due to attendance or discipline violations.
Coach or Sponsor	At the end of each grade-reporting period, determine whether any students failed to meet the academic criteria.
	For any student who fails to meet the academic criteria: Determine how long the student will be suspended from the activity; explain to the student the reason for the suspension; send a notice of the suspension to the student's parent(s)/guardian(s).
	For any student suspended for not meeting the academic criteria:
	At the end of the suspension, determine whether the student now meets the District's academic criteria. If so, notify the student and the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) that the student is now eligible to participate. If the student does not meet these criteria, notify the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) that the student will remain ineligible to participate until the student meets the academic criteria.
