Assemblies must be approved by the Butlding PrineipalSuperintendent or designee and be consistent with the Distriet'sDistrict's educational objectives.
The DistrietWhile the District respects an individual's brief, quiet, personal religious observance(s), it shall not endorse or otherwise promote invocations, benedictions, and group prayers at any school assembly, ceremony, or other school-sponsored activity.
