## Student Assignment and Intra-District Transfer

Attendance Areas

The School District is divided into school attendance areas. The Superintendent will-review:

- 1. <u>Review</u> the boundary lines annually and recommend <del>any changes</del> to the School Board-<u>any</u> <u>changes or revisions for existing units; or</u>
- 2. Create new units using a lens that considers preventing segregation and the elimination of separating students in the District's schools because of color, race, or nationality.

The Superintendent or designee shall maintain a map of the District showing current school attendance areas. <u>All records pertaining to the creation, alteration, or revision of attendance units are open to the public.</u> Students living in a given school attendance area will be assigned to that school. Homeless children shall be assigned according to <u>Board</u> policy 6:140, *Education of Homeless Children*.

Transfers Within the District

The Board of Education allows several options <u>A student's parent(s)/guardian(s) may request a transfer</u> for <u>students</u> to <u>attend various schools</u> within the district. It is a goal of the <u>a</u> District to maintain class size limits within the various grade levels of the various attendance centers.

- Students shall attend their local school as defined by the map mentioned above.
- <u>Students willother than the one assigned. A request should be required to attend another school</u> in the North Boone School District in order to maintain class size limits within the grade level.
- Students may participate in the Voluntary Transfer Program and attend any school in the district, in accordance with the procedures listed in Administrative Procedure 7:30.2.

The Board<u>directed to the Superintendent, who, at his or her sole discretion</u>, may grant an exception<u>the</u> request when the parent(s)/guardian(s) demonstrate that the student could be better accommodated by the education program at another school, provided space is available. Students who are <u>If a request is</u> granted a transfer within, the <u>Districtparent/guardian</u> shall be responsible for their own transportation. The provisions in this section have no applicability to transfers pursuant to the Unsafe School Choice Option covered in Board policy 4:170, *Safety*.

## Class Assignments

The Superintendent or designee shall assign students to classes.
