Students

Release Time for Religious Instruction/Observance

A student shall be released from school, as an excused absence, because of religious reasons, including to observe a religious holiday—or, for religious instruction—, or because the student's religion forbids secular activity on a particular day(s) or time of day. The student's parent/guardian must give written notice to the Building Principal at least 5 five calendar days before the student's anticipated absence—(s).

This notice shall satisfy the District's requirement for a written excuse when the student returns to school.

The Superintendent <u>or designee</u> shall develop and distribute to teachers appropriate procedures regarding student absences for <u>a religious reasons and include a list of religious holidays on which a student shall be excused from school attendance, religious reasons, including how teachers are notified of a <u>student's student's</u> impending absence, and the State law requirement that teachers provide the student with an equivalent opportunity to make up any examination, study, or work requirement.</u>
