**Roll Call**

**Items of Discussion**

Update on advertising-District is waiting on answer from ScoreBoard by Design on question regarding repairs on equipment.

Parking passes will be revisited to evaluate whether or not we will have again next year. It was recommended that we sell season passes at half price, \$25 for adults and \$15 for seniors and students, for the winter season. It was also suggested that we sell season passes at registration or put passes on student ids. Putting passes on ID may be an issue since Lifetouch provides our student IDs. Concerns were aired regarding the Capron Rescue Squad at North Boone football games. Numerous students were coming in the gate for the rescue squad without paying. Those students also came in and out of that entrance. Issues were also raised about the number of people entering through the trees on the front side of the football field. There was a discussion about the need for fencing on that side of the field.

Dr. Baule is working on a press release and a letter to the paper. They will include a thank you to all of those who have helped during the fall season. Dr. Baule asked to have any names forwarded to him. Buffalo Wild Wings raised \$200 for the Community Involvement Committee. Gayle will forward the check to the district office. Gayle will move forward with a second restaurant fundraiser at Arturo's in Poplar Grove in November. It was felt that the fundraiser would have a better chance at success if it There will be basketball games against Clinton held on January 22<sup>nd</sup>. Concessions on this day could be a fundraising opportunity.

Dale raised concerns with the volunteer ticket takers and suggested that we discuss going back to paid positions.

Other Business - The financial progress of the CIC was reviewed. We also discussed other fundraising opportunities with Market Day and Basketball Mania.
