1. Briefly describe how students will benefit from this program:

We will be giving 3rd & 4th grade students additional help to prepare for ISAT's. Students will be working with staff re-teaching and enriching lesson that will be addressed on the ISAT. We will enroll all who qualify. Capron continues to make AYP and this program is a definite reason why.

2. Describe the activities of this program:

The program will target reading skills. We would like to involve all students and will not discriminate against any. This will include addressing the needs of our bilingual students and students with an IEP.

3. Give a schedule of tentative dates and times for each activity.

Specifically, we are proposing that we offer after-school help for an hour approximately three times per week for four weeks. This will provide 10.85 hours of after-school help for these students. Total cost of project: 3 teachers x 10.85 hours x \$27.59 = \$898.05

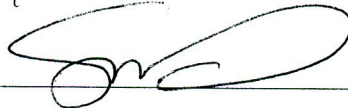
