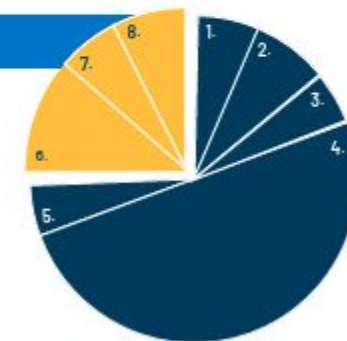

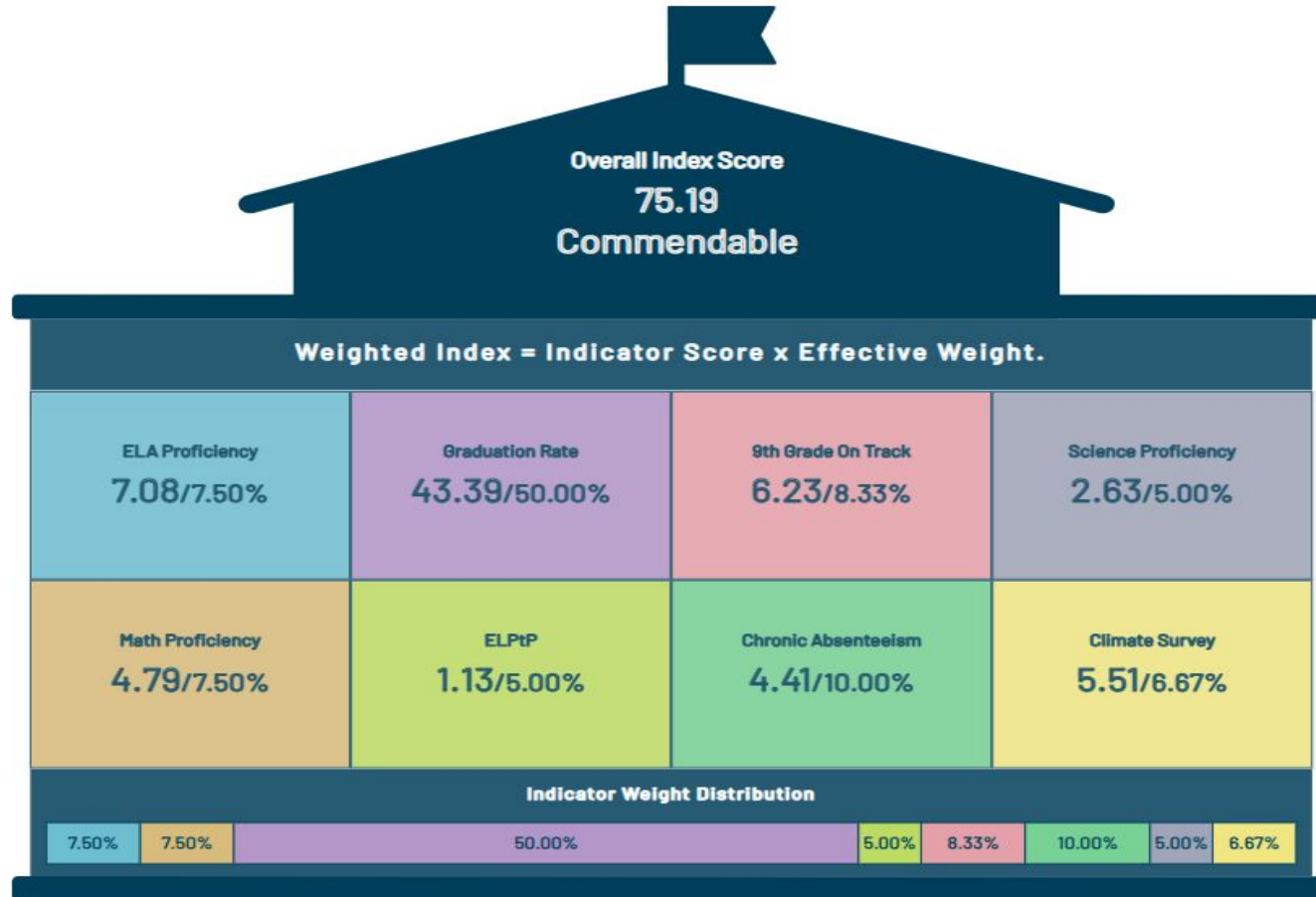

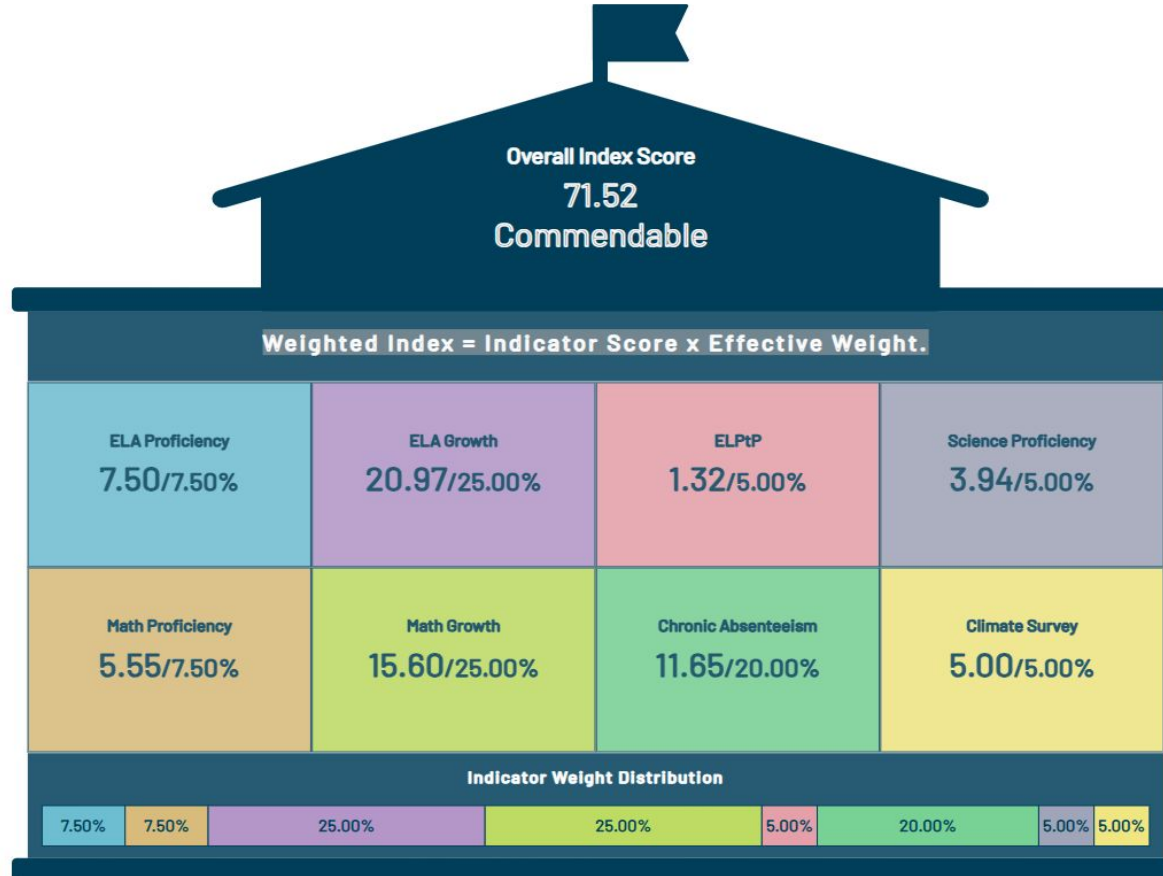

Updates for 2025 Report Card/State Data

High School Assessment

- Growth in ELA and math data reported this year (not an accountability measure)

IL Assessment of Readiness (Grades 3-8) and IL Science Assessment (Grades 5 & 8)

- The state realigned the cut scores, so we cannot compare achievement data to previous years

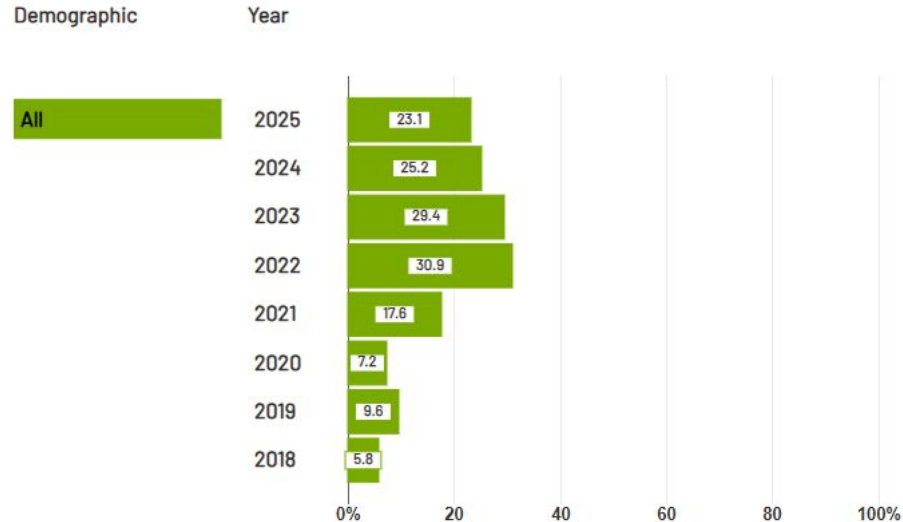
