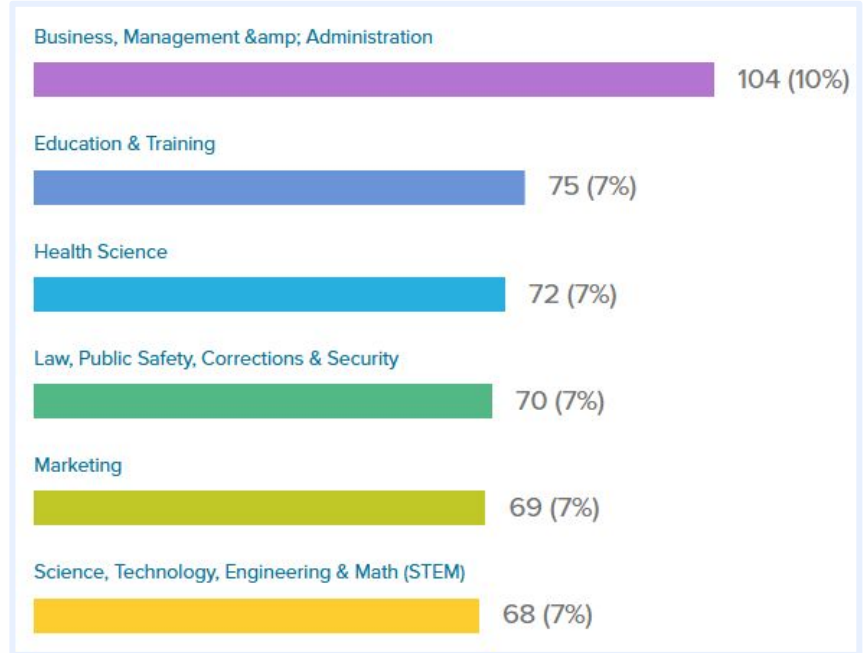
What are your current thoughts about life after high school?

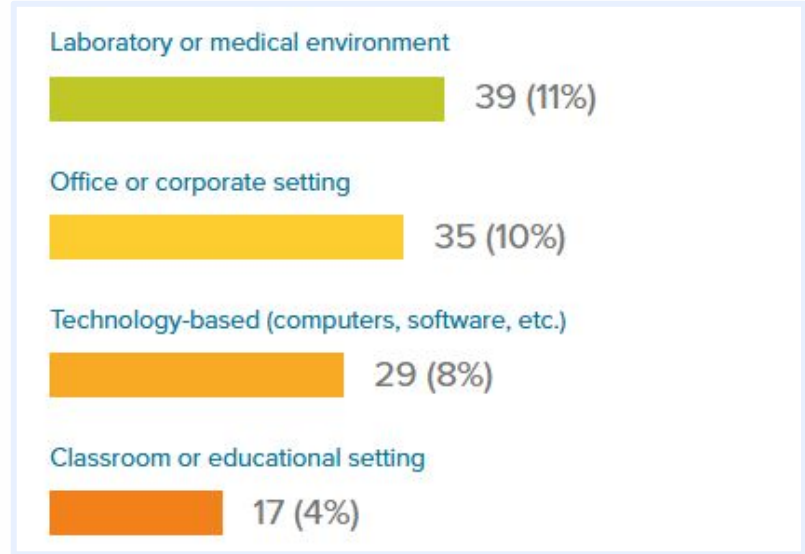
