Purpose

• 08/11/25 Business Services Committee reviewed FY26 tentative budget

• 08/19/25 Board of Education approved the FY26 tentative budget and authorized publishing of the public hearing notice

• 09/09/25 Business Services Committee reviewed the updated FY26 final budget

• 09/23/25 Board of Education holds budget hearing and votes on proposed FY26 final budget

• By 09/30/25 Administration files approved FY26 budget with Illinois State Board of Education, Boone County Clerk, Winnebago County Clerk, and Regional Office of Education and posts FY26 budget on D200 website.
