Nonresident Student Tuition 2025-2026

NBCUSD Policy

Only students who are residents of the District may attend a District's school without a tuition charge, except as otherwise provided in BOE Policy or in State law. A student's residence is the same as the person who has legal custody of the student. The residence of a child with a disability is determined in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/14-1.11, 5/14-1.11a, and 5/14-1.11b.

Request for Admission Process

Nonresident students may attend District schools upon the approval of a request submitted by the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) for nonresident admission. The Superintendent may approve the request subject to the following:

1. The student will attend on a year-to-year basis. *Approval for one year is not authorization to attend a following year.*
2. The student will be accepted only if there is sufficient room.
3. The student's parent(s)/guardian(s) will be charged the maximum amount of tuition as allowed by State law (see calculations below).
4. The student's parent(s)/guardian(s) will be responsible for transporting the student to and from school.

Calculation of Tuition

Below are the audited numbers, as provided by the Illinois State Board of Education, used to determine the tuition cost for the 2025-2026 school year.
