ATTACHMENT NO. X - B: Approval of K-4 Literacy Resource Adoption

Potential motion: Move to Approve the Adoption of Collaborate
Classroom: Collaborative Literacy for K-4 Literacy

Recommended action: Approve the motion.

The Administration recommends the purchase of Collaborative Classroom: Collaborative Literacy for K-4 Literacy for the total cost of \$316,915.00 for all materials. We also recommend the approval of the initial professional development for teachers for the total cost of \$7,000.00.

Year 1 Materials Cost: \$252,865.00

Years 2-6 Materials Cost: \$64,050.00

Initial Professional Development: \$7,000.00

Materials will be purchased from district funds as part of our resource adoption and curricular resources budget. Professional development will be purchased from Title II Grand Funds.

Recommendation for Adoption

Kindergarten - 4th Grade English Language Arts / Literacy Curriculum Resources

Rationale:

A new ELA resource for kindergarten through 4th grade will provide the following advantages for teachers and students.

- We are in need of a guaranteed and viable curriculum across grade levels and buildings. This adoption supports Goal 1, Strategy 3 of our Strategic Plan.
- Although we have curriculum maps at each level, we currently do not have a set curricular resource for ELA/Literacy.

Recommendation:

The *Collaborative Literacy* program published by Collaborative Classroom is recommended for adoption as our Kindergarten through 4th grade ELA/literacy resource. The following features of the program stand out as key reasons for our recommendation.

- Program is based on decades of research that tells how children learn and what they need to learn to be proficient readers.
- Uses evidence-based instructional practices.
- This curriculum will be easy to implement because the objectives are clear and concise.
- Program will set teachers and students up for success in the language arts/literacy areas.
- It promotes a positive learning environment for reading with a lot of opportunities for peer-to-peer collaboration.
- Social and academic needs are interdependent and integrated throughout the curriculum.
- This program is student-friendly and differentiated, so that students can fully engage with each lesson.
- Diversity is strong throughout the stories and lessons.
- Directly aligns to the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) and to the science of reading.
- There are multiple and varied opportunities for professional development that can be customized to our needs.

Process:

In order to arrive at this recommendation, our K-4 literacy committee engaged in the following process.

- October 2020 - March 2021
 - Met to build common understanding around the curriculum design and resource adoption process.
 - Selected priority standards by grade level.
 - Unpacked priority standards and aligned vertically for K-4.
- September 2021 - January 2022
 - Requested samples for the following resources: Savvas MyView, HMH Into Reading, Collaborative Classroom, Fountas & Pinnell Classroom, Units of Study, and McGraw Hill Open Court.

- Reviewed samples and provided each a rating in order to narrow to four resources for vendor presentations. Selected Savvas MyView, HMH Into Reading, Collaborative Classroom, and Fountas & Pinnell Classroom.
- After vendor presentations, selected Savvas MyView and Collaborative Classroom for a 2022-2023 pilot.
- Summer 2022 - March 2023
 - Met to plan for Savvas MyView pilot.
 - Piloted Savvas MyView during 1st Trimester.
 - Met to plan for Collaborative Classroom pilot.
 - Piloted Collaborative Classroom during 2nd Trimester.
 - Completed Resource Review rubrics for Savvas MyView and Collaborative Classroom in order to make a resource adoption recommendation.
