Suggested motion: Move to Approve

Recommended action: Approve as presented.

It is recommended that the Board approve the purchase of *Amplify Science* for 5th—8th grade science. This purchase includes three years of consumable and online resources at a total cost of \$70,233.19.

This purchase will come from local district funds.

Recommendation for Adoption 5th-8th Grade Science Curriculum Resources

Rationale:

A new science resource for 5th through 8th grade will provide the following advantages for teachers and students.

- Updated content with real-world applications.
- Hands-on and digital learning experiences for students.
- A comprehensive scope and sequence to develop critical thinking skills.

Recommendation:

Amplify Science is recommended for adoption as our 5th through 8th grade science resource. The following features of the program stand out as key reasons for our recommendation.

- Online platform is user friendly for teachers and students
- Digital simulations help students understand the science concepts
- Real-world connections to careers in science
- Data collection and analysis using critical thinking skills
- Rigorous content and learning experiences

Process:

In order to arrive at this recommendation, our science team engaged in the following process throughout the 2024-2025 school year.

- The science team met in September to review the adoption process, to review potential resources, and to select resources for vendor presentations.
- In November, the science team engaged in vendor presentations from *Amplify Science* and *HMH Into Science*. The team selected *Amplify Science* to field test with students.
- In January, Amplify Science provided professional development for the field test and the teachers had time to plan for their field test units. The field test with students took place February March.
- In April, the team met to complete the resource evaluation rubric and make their recommendation.
