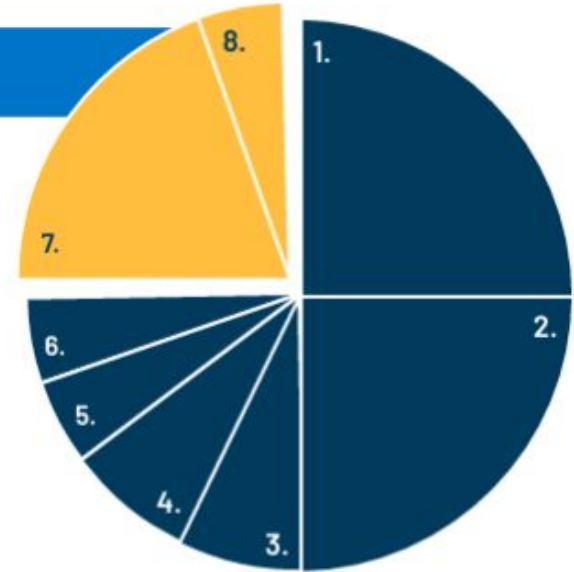

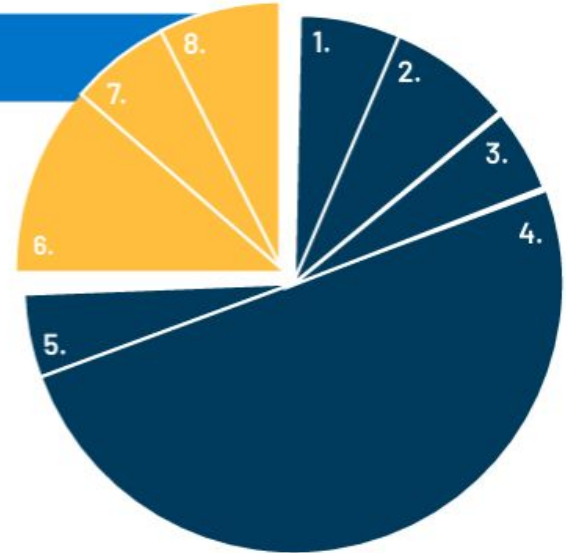

# Next Steps

1. School Leadership Teams meet at least once a month to review progress on their school improvement plans.
