Current Lunch Pricing

- **Current Lunch Pricing is:**
 - K-4: \$3.35 and 5-12: \$3.50
- FY26 Target Price was **\$4.16**
- **Weighted Average Paid Lunch Price 25-26: \$3.44**
- **Paid Lunch Equity Requirement: \$3.86**
- ***Requirements & Options***
 - ISBE can only ***require*** a maximum increase of \$0.10
 - Adult lunch is a minimum of \$0.50 over student pricing
 - Increase the lunch at the minimum ISBE requirement; increase to get closer to the USDA target price; raise prices to meet the USDA target price

Lunch Price Options

- **Option 1 - Minimum increase per ISBE**
 - K-4: \$3.45 and 5-12: \$3.60
- **Option 2 - Increase closer to the USDA target price**
 - K-4: \$3.65 and 5-12: \$3.90
- **Option 3 - One Price K-12 closer to the USDA target price**
 - K-12: \$3.60
- **Option 4: Move to the Paid Lunch Equity Target price**
 - K-12: \$3.86
