ATTACHMENT NO. XII.-C: Student Aide Proposal

Potential motion: Move to Approve the Student Aide Proposal for NBHS

Recommended action: Approve as presented.

During the Fall of 2023, Mr. Eckmann worked with teachers to create a pass/fail course for juniors and seniors who wish to become a student aide working with teachers and in classrooms. This course would provide an additional elective option for students and aligns to ISBE's career pathways. The Administration recommends approving the Student Aide Proposal as presented. Once approved, this course would be included in the NBHS 2024-2025 Course Guide.

Requirements for Eligibility?

Qualified students must be a junior or senior and be on track for graduation.

Qualified students must have been absent 10 or less days during the previous semester.

Qualified students must not have received an in-school suspension or an out of school suspension.

Students who go to other schools must have parent permission to leave campus and drive.

Students will earn a ½ credit each semester they are a student-aide. The grade will be pass-fail. The grade will not count toward a student's grade point average.

The classroom teacher will have the final decision regarding hosting a student-aide and who the student aide will be.

What can a student aide do?

Assist individual students or small groups of students

Hang bulletin boards

Create class materials

Set-up and take down labs

Organize classrooms

Set-up and take down for PE classes

Pass-out assignments to students

What can a student aide not do?

Grade student work

Enter graded student work into PowerSchool

Record attendance in PowerSchool

Supervise students individually, in small groups, or whole class
